- Why Digital Measures?
 - Used by over 60% of US AACSB business schools
 - Other OSU colleges using DM: Engineering, PHHS, AgSci, Forestry, Pharmacy
 - Supports AACSB reporting requirements
 - Student credit hours by discipline/location
 - Faculty qualifications and sufficiency
 - Research impact of Intellectual contributions
 - Student Evaluation of Teaching scores
 - Source for research articles that appear on COB website under “My Publications”
 - Annual faculty reporting evaluations
 - OSU Promotion & Tenure CV template
 - Track COB EDI activities
 - Single sign-on using ONID credentials/Duo

Considerations for updating Digital Measures

- New records created for incoming faculty based on hiring CV, LinkedIn, Google Scholar
 - All research faculty strongly encouraged to get a Google Scholar profile and share with Malcolm/Byron (goal is 100% of research faculty)
 - COB “scrapes” Google Scholar to generate reports on citations per author and per article
- Teaching results loaded for faculty after end of each term
- John Womack monitors the WaterCooler for announcements on new publications and updates DM as needed.
 - John updates COB faculty bio website on regular basis or when asked
- Faculty option on frequency of updating DM (real-time, once a month, once a term...)
- **Annual Faculty Reports** - due to supervisors early spring term (after winter term grades loaded). Covers last three years (April 2017 – March 2020)
- **COB Research Activity Reports** - due to Jonathan Arthurs early spring term. Covers last year (April 2019 - March 2020)
 - Focused on acceptance dates
 - Operations Group tries to keep up on publication dates to close out record
- **OSU Promotion and Tenure Vita** – DM provides template for OSU requirements. Formatting is imperfect but good starting place

Teaching Results and Electronic – Student Evaluation of Teaching (eSET) scores

- eSET scores are received and processed into DM 7-10 days after grades posted.
- No need to create/enter teaching results (course, GPA, term, enrollment) for OSU courses as they will be duplicated or overwritten
- OSU does not provide eSET scores for classes with enrollment less than six
- OSU does not provide COB with eSET scores for Honors college courses taught by COB faculty – “BA 352H”

Key tables:

- **Advising** – # number of students advised/year + summary of advising activities. Avoid listing students advised
- **Student Committees** – typically graduate student committees or honors college thesis committees
- **Service** – organization, annual hours, responsibilities, dates, role, professionally related
- **Professional Development**
 - Licenses – description, dates obtained/expiration
 - Consulting – organization, hours, compensated, description, start/end dates
 - Faculty Development – dates and descriptions (hours) for course work, conferences, workshops
 - Professional Memberships – Organization, role, description, dates

AACSB terms

- **Scholarly Academic (SA)** – tenured/tenure-track research faculty with doctoral degree
- **Practice Academic (PA)** – instructors with doctoral degree
- **Scholarly Practitioner (SP)** – instructors with master's degree and engaged in scholarly activities
- **Instructional Practitioner (IP)** - instructors with master's degree and current professional experience (5 years)
- 90% of faculty need to be in one of these four categories for each discipline/location
- **Participating vs Supporting** – COB defines Participating as all instructional faculty whose FTE is at least 0.50 during the current year. Participating faculty are expected to engage in the activities of the college beyond teaching.

Need evidence of recent work and/or two engagement activities in last five years. Examples for professional engagement activities for IP:

- Work: full or part-time
- Significant consulting experience (approved by school head)
- Professional development, maintain certification, attend professional conferences
- Active member on board
- Intellectual contributions: books, peer or non-peer reviewed journals, newspaper article
- 30 units of education in teaching area
- Presentations

AACSB – assessing research impact

The college considers a journal to be impactful if the journal (1) is on the Financial Times (FT) 50 journal list, (2) is in the most recent Association of Business Schools Academic Journal Quality Guide (ABS) grade 3 or above, or (3) is in the most recent Australian Business Deans Council (ABDC) Journal Quality List rank A* or A journal list. The college considers the first quartile in a statistics subject category in the Scimago Journal & Country Rank portal. For Law, the college considers the top 100 of all law reviews (6%), top 20% of any specialty law category, specialty law reviews housed at a top 25 law school and American Business Law Journal.

Tier 1 – Premier, ABS 4* (impactful)

Tier 2 – Excellent, ABS 4 (impactful)

Tier 3 – ABS 3 or Scimago first quartile (impactful)

Tier 4 – ABS 2 or equivalent (other)

Journal articles are added to the COB faculty bio pages through an automatic process that is triggered manually. John Womack updates this process 1-2 times per month or when requested

Intellectual Contributions

- Every type of contribution should be listed (Journals, books, book reviews, broadcast media, conference proceedings, newspaper articles, written case, software, other)
- Peer reviewed journal articles will be available for display on COB website – share
- **Select AACSB Classification:**
 - Basic or Discovery Scholarship (most research faculty typically pick this for peer-reviewed articles)
 - Applied or Integration/Application Scholarship (most IP faculty will typically pick this)
 - Teaching and Learning Scholarship

- Select **authors** – add number of authors and enter/select names, roles, order of appearance
 - Current and previous COB faculty can be selected
 - Automatically populates records for all COB authors
